Employment of a Level 1 Sports Apprentice	Sports apprentice assisted with the development of some extra-curricular clubs enabling them to improve in quality. He also supported our Play Pal scheme and provision of additional informal sports opportunities.
Membership of the North Herts School Sports Partnership (NHSSP)	Opportunities for many intra school and inter school sports club links. Training for staff and pupils. Training and support for our Sports and Physical Education.
Attendance of the NHSSP 2012 Olympic Legacy event	Opportunity for all Year 6 pupils to participate in a cross-country competition and try some new sports such as orienteering.
Funding pupils who need Top Up swimming to meet the 25m National Curriculum level	Increased number of pupils with improved swimming ability.
Purchase of specialist Sports Hall Athletics equipment	Year 6 teachers able to deliver a Sports Hall Athletics lesson. All teachers able to use equipment for PE lessons as an alternative to a 'rainy day PE lesson'. Equipment used in preparation for competition.
Employment of a Lunchtime Play Supervisor	Games and activities promoted at lunchtime leading to higher levels of activity.
Continued development of extra-curricular clubs to offer opportunities to all	Increased number of pupils, from all year groups, participating in extra-curricular clubs.
New rubber matting to be laid amongst fixed play equipment	Increased area for Play Pal use and improved safety during the winter months when we are unable to use the outdoor play equipment.
Staff training and release time for development of PE	Continued delivery of quality PE lessons and addressing staff training needs.
