What We Did & What We Learnt:

Crazy Critters - Frogs

- We looked at amphibians - frogs & toads
- We looked at the frog lifecycle and metamorphosis with models (plastic & Taxidermy) and time lapse video clips
- We looked at different species of frogs and fun facts on each including size variations and habitat
- We used the tape measure to look at the difference in sizes and to see how far frogs can jump / fly (Wallace flying frog - 50ft)!
- We looked at different examples of frogs eggs and how they care for their young, including the Pipa Pipa that carries its eggs on its back until froglets emerge!
- We looked at an anatomical 4D model of the frog
- We looked at how frogs catch insects with their tongues and we made our own froggy tongue, using dexterity to fold, cut, curl, stick and blow
