
#### Hartsfield Children's Online Safety Survey Results Autumn 2018

If so what do you use?




# Do you know how to use the privacy and security settings on these devices?

Yes: 47% No: 53%


Do you have a mobile phone that you can use to access the internet?

# During the weekend, how long do you spend (in hours) on the internet each day?




Does your mum or dad discuss internet safety with you?



Do you know more than your mum or dad about online safety?


Yes: 31% No: 69%

Years 5 and 6 completed a 'top up' survey as part of Anti-cyber-bullying day.




#### Do your parents know when you go/ play online?
